We are looking for a Senior Cardiac Physiologist to join our experienced and friendly team in the heart of the Scottish Highlands.

Based at Raigmore Hospital in Inverness you will be expected to perform a range of Cardiac tests including Pacemaker/ICD/CRT implant and follow up. ETT, Holter and event recorder fitting and analysis and work in the Cardiac Cath lab where we perform angios, angioplasty and IVUS etc.

You will also be expected to attend peripheral pacemaker clinics throughout the Highlands and Islands on a regular basis.

Although priority will be given to a qualified and experienced cardiac physiologist, an Annex U (21) trainee position may be available for suitable candidates with an appropriate degree in Cardiac Physiology. A trainee would be expected to undertake in house training to achieve the competencies required of the band 6 post and professional registration, with the agreed training period determined from existing experience.
